Family Definitions

- A "family" <u>must</u> include at least 1 <u>dependent child</u>.
 Dependent child must be under 18 and unmarried, or they may be 19 if they are a full-time student in high school, or at an equivalent level in vocation or technical training.
- The adult applying for the program could be a:
 - Custodial parent (including adoptive parent); or,
 - Non-custodial parent (as long as both the non-custodial parent and the child live in the State of Ohio); or,
 - Blood relative (including those of half-blood, within the relationship of siblings, first cousins, nephews, nieces, aunts, uncles and individuals of preceding generations as denoted by prefixes of grand, great, great-great, etc. This group includes relatives within the fifth degree of kinship to the dependent child; therefore, this includes first cousins once removed, but not the second cousins).
